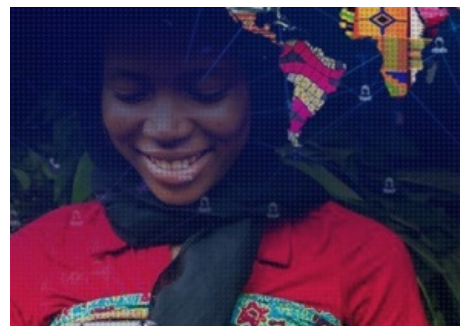


**EKOME presents as national partner, EduMediaTest 2.0.**, the new European interactive tool for evaluation and training on media and digital literacy skills in the classroom. The project is the outcome of the EU consortium of 7 countries (France, Croatia, Portugal, Slovakia, Spain, Greece, Ireland) with project leader Audiovisual Council of Catalonia (CAC) in Spain. EduMediaTest is an Open Educational Resource for the school community, comprising of an interactive questionnaire for students and a Media Kit for teachers to assess and discuss media and digital literacy skills in Secondary Education.
